Whereas, Physical therapists have the foundational education to practice in and support critical areas of patient and community care; and,

Whereas, Physical therapists provide value in emergency care contexts through, but not limited to, pain reduction, decreased waiting times, early access, cost savings, and patient satisfaction;

Resolved, That the American Physical Therapy Association supports emergency physical therapist practice.
