Dr. Stephenson is Coordinator of Women's Health Physical Therapy at the Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts and is adjunct faculty in the physical therapy program at the Massachusetts General Institute of Health Professions in Boston, Massachusetts. She is President of the International Organization of Physical Therapists in Women's Health, (IOPTWH) a sub-group of the World Confederation for Physical Therapy. Dr. Stephenson is a graduate of Boston University, a certified childbirth educator, certified lymphadema therapist, and received her masters and doctorate from the Massachusetts General Hospital Institute of Health Professions.
