



OFFICIAL RULES – 2019 COMBINED SECTIONS MEETING GIVE AWAY DRAWING

The American Physical Therapy Association (“APTA”) is a § 501(c)(6) not-for-profit organization, located at 1111 N. Fairfax Street, Alexandria, VA 22314. In connection with the 2019 Combined Sections Meeting (“CSM” or “Meeting”) to be held in Washington, DC, the APTA will be holding a Drawing to award certain prizes pursuant to these Official Rules. The prizes are provided courtesy of the District of Columbia Convention and Visitors Bureau.

NO FEE OR PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE OF ANY KIND WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

1. Prizes: The seven prizes are as follows:

- (i) 1 round trip ticket good for economy domestic air travel to CSM 2019*
- (ii) 1 round trip ticket good for economy domestic air travel to CSM 2019*
- (iii) 2 tickets to Old Town DC Trolley
- (iv) 2 tickets to Big Bus tour
- (v) 2 tickets to Madame Tussauds
- (vi) 2 tickets to the Newseum
- (vii) 1 DC Themed Gift Basket

* Excludes travel from or to Alaska or Hawaii.

2. Odds: The odds of winning will be determined by the total number of eligible entries.

3. Void Where Prohibited by Law: This contest is void in any state where prohibited or otherwise restricted by law.

4. Drawing Date: The APTA will determine the winners on or before November 5, 2018.

5. Entries: You must be 21 years of age or older and a legal resident of the United States to enter. By participating, you accept these Official Rules and agree that the decisions of the APTA interpreting and applying these Official Rules shall be final and binding in all respects.

You may enter only once, under either method (A) or method (B) below. You may not enter under both methods.

(A) **CSM Registration**

Navigate to the CSM 2019 Rates & Registration page on the APTA's website, at <http://www.apta.org/CSM/Registration/>, and register for CSM.

Individuals who register for CSM before 11:59 p.m., Eastern Time, on October 24, 2018, will be automatically entered in the Drawing. Such individuals may not submit mail entries as described in method (B) below.

(B) **Mail Entry**

You do not need to register for CSM 2019 to enter. Any person wishing to participate in the Drawing may submit an Entry Form. Each submitted Entry Form must be a three inch by five inch piece of paper that contains your name, complete email address, complete postal address, telephone number, and the words "APTA CSM 2019 Give Away". Entry Forms must be sent to the following address, with proper postage affixed, by regular mail, and received before 11:59 p.m., Eastern Time, on October 24, 2018.

Only one Entry Form per envelope. You may send only one envelope. Incorrect, illegible, and incomplete entries are void. Once submitted, Entry Forms become the exclusive property of APTA and will not be returned.

6. Winner Selection: Selection of winners will be made by random selection from among the entries. The winners will be notified by telephone and/or email. If a person selected to win prize (i) or (ii) already has purchased a nonrefundable air travel ticket to CSM 2019, then he/she will have 24-hours from notification to declare that he/she wishes to exchange prize (i) or (ii) for one of the other prizes.

7. Claiming Prize:

Permission: A winner's acceptance of a prize constitutes a grant of permission for the APTA to use the winner's name, voice, pictures, likenesses, and city and state of residences, and any other information provided (with the exception of physical address, email, and phone number) for purposes of trade, publicity, or promotion (except where prohibited) in any medium of communication, including print, Internet, radio and/or television for any purpose, including advertising, promotional, or other purposes, by the APTA, its affiliates, partners, and sponsors.

11. Additional Terms: By entering the Drawing, each participant agrees to release, discharge, and hold harmless the APTA, its affiliates, subsidiaries, officers, directors, employees, and agents from any and all damages, costs, expenses, and other liabilities, including damages for personal injury or damage to property, whether the damages are direct or indirect, and regardless of whether the claim is based on contract, tort, or any other legal theory, which may be due to or arise out of participation in or operation of the Drawing or any portion thereof or the acceptance, use/misuse, or possession of the prize.

By entering, each participant further agrees that no warranty, representation, or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or law, has been made with respect to the prize. Entries that are lost, late, misdirected, incorrect, garbled, or incompletely received, for any reason, including by reason of hardware, software, browser, or network failure, malfunction, congestion, or incompatibility at servers or elsewhere, will not be eligible. The APTA, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person tampering with the entry process or the operation of the APTA web site. The APTA further reserves the right to cancel, terminate, or modify the Drawing if completion of the Drawing as planned becomes impossible or unfeasible for any reason, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, technical failures of any sort, or force majeure.

These Official Rules are subject to any requirements/limitations imposed by Federal or State laws. These Official Rules shall be governed and enforced pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
