



# Related Organizations

## **BOD Y03-21-03-07 [Policy]**

Related organizations are controlled subsidiaries of the American Physical Therapy Association that are organized under the appropriate law and designation to meet their purpose.

- I. Related organizations shall operate under the following guiding principles:
  - A. APTA-related organizations conduct their activities in accordance with the highest ethical and operational standards.
  - B. Policies of APTA-related organizations shall not be inconsistent or conflict with APTA policies.
  - C. Bylaws and policies of APTA-related organizations, and subsequent amendments, are effective only after approval by the APTA Board of Directors.
  - D. Each APTA-related organization shall annually submit at a minimum the following to the APTA Board:
    1. Audited financials.
    2. Annual operating budget.
    3. Annual report covering key accomplishments and key business plans.

### **Explanation of Reference Numbers:**

HOD P00-00-00-00 stands for House of Delegates/month/year/page/vote in the House of Delegates minutes; the "P" indicates that it is a position (see below). For example, HOD P06-17-05-04 means that this position can be found in the June 2017 House of Delegates minutes on Page 5 and that it was Vote 4.
