- 3 The committee shall be the point of contact and meet at least annually with the Treasurer and the Association's
- 4 independent auditors to discuss the annual audit. The committee shall advise the Board of Directors of any
- 5 irregularities or material findings that arise from the independent audit or other sources.

CHARGE

7 The Board of Directors' determined charge for the Audit Committee is to:

- Participate in the financial information session for Component Leaders at APTA's Combined Sections Meeting.
- Serve as the association's audit committee and meet with the auditors annually to determine the scope of work and review the audit results.
- Provide oversight of the association's regulatory compliance, risk management, and whistleblower complaints.
- Conduct an annual review of the APTA Travel Expense Reimbursement quidelines.
- Provide recommendations, at the request of the Board, regarding programs for investment, redirection, or divestment.
- Advise and counsel the APTA Board of Directors on proposed and existing Association policies, positions, and the APTA Code of Ethics for the Physical Therapy Profession, as requested.
- Coordinate and collaborate with other APTA appointed groups and stakeholders, when doing so can further the work of the committee.
- Submit an annual report to the Board of Directors.
- 22 All APTA appointed groups shall conduct their work to support APTA's Mission, Vision, Strategic Plan, and
- APTA adopted policies and positions. All appointees shall agree to the APTA Volunteer Commitment. 23

TERMS



- With the exception of the Board chair, committee members shall serve three-year terms and shall not serve 1
