

2024 Tax Information

APTA dues may be tax deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense. See below for the portion of your national and component dues that is not deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense to the extent that APTA and your chapter, section, or academy engages in lobbying.

Donations to the Foundation for Physical Therapy Research, Dimensions of Diversity Fund, Minority Scholarship Fund, and Physical Therapy Fund are recognized as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.

APTA membership dues, World Physiotherapy Fund contributions, and PTPAC contributions are not tax deductible as charitable contributions.

- The nondeductible portion of your national dues is 15%.
- All section and academy dues except for the following may be fully deductible:
 - o Academy of Orthopaedic Physical Therapy: 23% of dues is not deductible.
 - o Private Practice Section: 32% of dues is not deductible.
