Accessibility Policy

The American Physical Therapy Association is committed to making the APTA Combined Sections Meeting accessible to all persons. Anyone requiring accommodations due to a disability to participate in APTA CSM is asked to check the appropriate Americans with Disabilities Act box when registering for the conference and/or reserving housing and noting the details of your requirements. Specific requests also can be made directly by email (conferences@apta.org) or by phone at 703-706-8510.

Event Locations

APTA CSM programming and activities will occur at four locations: Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center (900 E. Market St., San Antonio, TX 78205), Grand Hyatt (600 E. Market St., San Antonio, TX 78205), Marriott Riverwalk (889 E. Market St., San Antonio, TX 78205), and Marriot Rivercenter (101 Bowie St., San Antonio, TX 78205).

Schedules

Educational sessions will begin and end at the same time each day Thursday through Saturday, with one to two hours between sessions to provide ample time for attendees to get to their next session.

Hotel Reservations for Accessible Rooms

The co-headquarters hotels for APTA CSM are the Grand Hyatt, Marriott Riverwalk, and Marriott Rivercenter. APTA has reserved a number of accessible rooms at each sponsored hotel. Grand Hyatt

Entrances and Exits



The Grand Hyatt main entrance, located at 600 E. Market St., is accessible for all patrons.

Parking Lots



Accessible valet parking is available at the Grand Hyatt and rates include in/out privileges. Valet parking for overnight hotel guests is \$49 daily, plus taxes. Daily self- and overnight parking for hotel guests is \$38, plus taxes.

Marriott Riverwalk

Entrances and Exits



The Marriott Riverwalk main entrance, located at 889 E. Market St., is accessible for all patrons.

Parking Lots



Accessible valet parking is available at the Marriott Riverwalk and rates include unlimited in/out privileges. Valet parking for overnight hotel guests is \$49 daily, plus taxes. No self-parking is offered at this location.

Marriott Rivercenter

Entrances and Exits



The Marriott Rivercenter main entrance, located at 101 Bowie St., is accessible for all patrons.

Parking Lots



Accessible valet parking is available at the Marriott Rivercenter and rates include unlimited in/out privileges. With multiple level garage and handicap parking spots, daily self-parking fee for overnight hotel guests is \$38, plus taxes. Valet parking fee for overnight hotel guests is \$48 daily, plus taxes.

Disability Parking

Disabled persons license plates and placards from any state will be honored in Texas, provided the placard/plate is valid. If you need a disability parking placard, please apply in advance through your state's Department of Motor Vehicles office.

Taxicabs



The Americans with Disabilities Act requires all ground transportation companies provide accessible vehicles. It is recommended that individuals requiring this service make arrangements in advance with their chosen service provider. To order an accessible taxi, call Yellow Cab for the Greater San Antonio area, 24 hours a day, seven days a week, at 210-222-2222, or for more information visit yellowcabsa.com. On-demand ADA accessible vehicles are available. Arrangements and payments for such transportation are the responsibility of the attendee.

Mobility Constraints



Due to the size of the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center, Grand Hyatt, Marriott Riverwalk, and Marriott Rivercenter, the distance between sessions can be considerable. If you regularly use a wheelchair, you should bring your chair. For attendees who do not bring their own wheelchair or have mobility needs that may require assistance, please make arrangements prior to arriving on-site, as the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center is not able to provide wheelchairs. If you require assistance, consider making arrangements to rent an electronic scooter. To order a mobility device, contact Scootaround toll-free at 888-441-7575 or info@scootaround.com. Make your reservation early to ensure availability. All arrangements are the attendees' responsibility. Scootaround can deliver to the convention center (you must be present for delivery) or your hotel.

- Scootaround rentals: \$210 for a three-day minimum, and \$280 when rented for four days to a week. Please note that prices and minimums are subject to change.

Entrances and Exits



The main entrance of the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center, located at 900 E. Market St., has multiple automatic entry doors and is accessible for all patrons.

Parking Lots



Accessible parking is available in the surrounding lots and garages, including a city parking facility across the street from the convention center, where fees apply. This is available on a first come, first-served basis. Spaces are marked accordingly, as well as spaces designated for van access only.

First-Aid Stations

The first aid station is located in the exhibit hall.
