7 **CHARGE**

- 8 • The Elections Committee oversees the APTA national elections, including the candidacy
9 and elections phases, and shall adhere to all appropriate laws and APTA bylaws, policies,
10 and the committee charter.
11 • Submit an annual report to the Board of Directors.

13 **QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTEES**

- 14 • Shall be an APTA member in good standing.
15 • Knowledge of APTA's national election structure.
16 • Ability to maintain neutrality and confidentiality throughout the candidacy and election
17 cycles.
18 • Ability to anticipate challenges and remain calm and confident under pressure.
19 • Comfort with technology.
20 • May not serve concurrently in the House of Delegates.
21 • Abide by the APTA Volunteer Commitment, which includes an agreement to not run for
22 APTA elected office within three years from the final date of service on the committee.

24 All APTA appointed groups shall conduct their work to support APTA's Mission, Vision,
25 Strategic Plan, and APTA adopted policies and positions. All appointees must agree to the
26 APTA Volunteer Commitment.

28 **MEETINGS**

29 This committee holds one annual funded in-person meeting and meets on a monthly basis,
30 as needed.

31

32 **SIZE OF APPOINTED GROUP**

33 The Elections Committee consists of six (6) members: one chair, one vice chair, and four
34 additional members. The Elections Committee shall have a Board liaison selected annually
35 by the President provided the liaison agrees to not consider running for any elected position
36 on the APTA Board of Directors or APTA Nominating Committee for the year in which they
37 are appointed.

1 **TERMS OF APPOINTEES**

2 Committee members shall serve three-year terms and shall not serve consecutive terms for
3 appointments beginning in 2026 or thereafter. Beginning in 2029, APTA members shall not
4 serve on more than one board-appointed group at a time with the exception of APTA Board
5 members.
