Component Bylaws Approval Process

The officers of the House of Delegates, on behalf of the APTA Board of Directors, may exercise the Board's authority as required by the Bylaws of the American Physical Therapy Association to approve component and institutional group bylaws and subsequent amendments to bylaws before they go into effect.

Component and Institutional Group Articles or Certificates of Incorporation Approval Process The Board approves component and institutional group articles or certificates of incorporation and subsequent amendments prior to filing with the respective state authority.

Component and Institutional Group Policies and Positions APTA expects component and institutional group policies and position statements to align without conflict with APTA policies and position statements.
