

Definition of Underrepresented Minority Populations in Physical Therapy Education



HOD P06-20-27-23 [Amended HOD P06-14-13-08] [Position]

The American Physical Therapy Association defines "Underrepresented" in physical therapy education as the racial and ethnic populations that are underrepresented in physical therapy education relative to their numbers in the general population, as well as individuals from geographically underrepresented areas, from lower economic strata, and from educationally disadvantaged backgrounds, and with disabilities.

Explanation of Reference Numbers:

HOD P00-00-00-00 stands for House of Delegates/month/year/page/vote in the House of Delegates minutes; the "P" indicates that it is a position (see below). For example, HOD P06-17-05-04 means that this position can be found in the June 2017 House of Delegates minutes on Page 5 and that it was Vote 4.
